

CMTA Event Covid Protocols and Procedures

1. All persons entering the building must wear a mask, covering nose and mouth when in the building. Do not participate or enter this site if you have Covid-19 and your first symptoms began less than 10 days ago. If your first symptoms began 10 or more days before the event and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, you may enter/participate.
2. Do not enter the site if in the last 48 hours you have had any of the following symptoms, not due to a pre-existing medical condition or diagnosis unrelated to Covid-19: fever (100.4 F or higher) or chills, cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; fatigue; muscle or body aches; headache; new loss of taste or smell; sore throat; congestion or runny nose; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea.
3. Do not enter this site if you have been in prolonged close physical contact with anyone with Covid-19 in the past 10 days.
4. Maintain distance from others outside of your family whenever possible.
5. In order to reduce the number of people in the waiting area, students who arrive more than five minutes before their performance time should either wait outside or return to their vehicles after checking in. Students may return to the building at the appointed time and will be instructed on where to sit.
6. Performers must sanitize their hands before and after performing. If hand sanitizer cannot be used, students must wash their hands in the restroom, before and after playing.
7. If weather permits, students should wait outside for their music to be returned. Otherwise, wait inside, maintaining social distancing as much as possible.
8. All attendees (teachers and students/parents) are required to sign a waiver of liability in order to participate in the event. The waiver will be kept on file and is applicable to all events for the current school year. By participating in this event you are asserting that you have submitted a waiver for the school year.
